Renovation Project Coming in February

In February, the library will undergo a major interior renovation project, which will include painting, replacing the carpeting, installing new service desks, and relocating the Children's Department.

This is the first major renovation of the building, which was built in 1991. All of the components of the project are geared to making the library user-friendly, welcoming, and a pleasant place to visit.

The scope of the project will require the library to be closed for business from January 27th until March 1st. During this time, Acorn Public Library in Oak Forest will be processing our interlibrary loans, and Acorn and Crestwood Public Library will assist patrons by placing holds and providing other patron services.
